Research Modules should be taken in a student's first year of study. The number of credits you can enroll in will be capped if you have not completed the required Research Modules.

Modules 1 – 4 are required for **all diploma and degree students**. These are non-credit, no-fee research modules in Information Literacy. The research modules will engage students in hands-on as well as theoretical work intended to develop knowledgeable, disciplined and critically astute researchers.
